There is a six hour service requirement over the course of the school year. However, we encourage students to give as much of their time as they choose. The Service Crew will be on an on-call basis and students will be able to sign up for volunteer opportunities that interest them. Volunteer opportunities may include:

- Caring For Kids
- Christmas Bureau
- Spring Clean Up
- Food For All Farm
